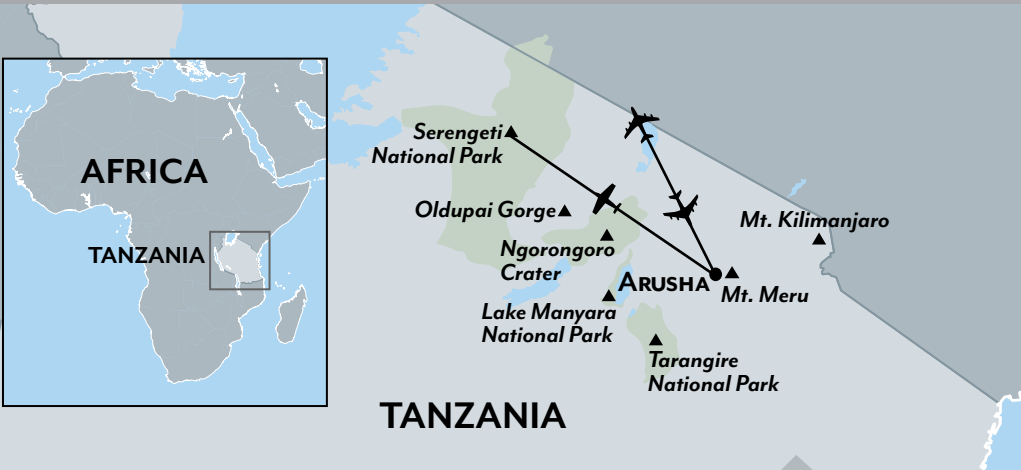

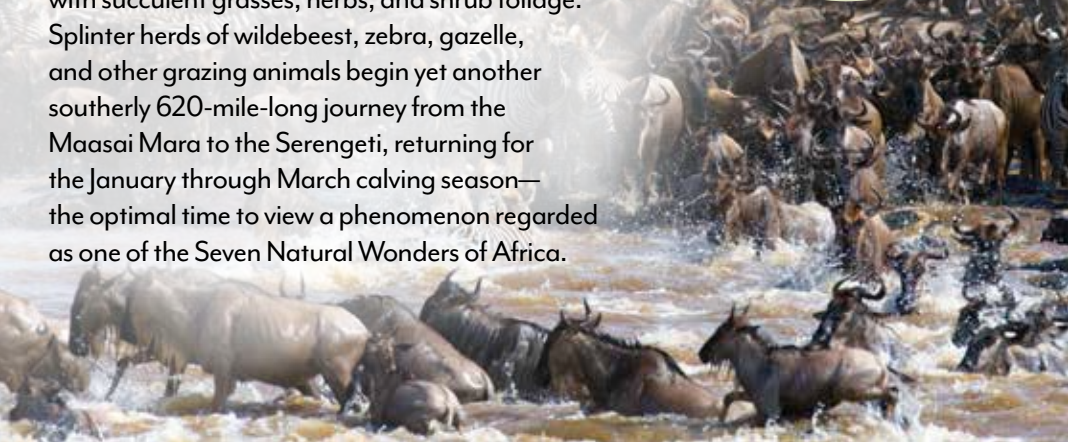
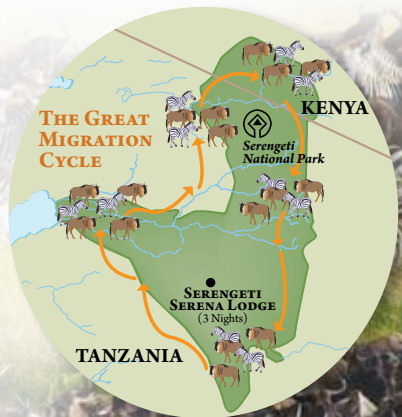

# Ancient Rhythms of the Serengeti



Home to the Big Five, the “endless plains” of the Serengeti and its abundant diversity of natural habitats set the scene for a seasonal migration unlike any other in the world. A spectacular profusion of wildlife harmoniously coexists with semi-nomadic Maasai herdsmen and warriors who have roamed its trackless grasslands for centuries. The key to the vitality of the Serengeti lies in the seasonal migrations of wildlife in a rhythmic cycle triggered by a search for water. By November of each year, the Serengeti’s savannas have been replenished by heavy rains with succulent grasses, herbs, and shrub foliage. Splinter herds of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, and other grazing animals begin yet another southerly 620-mile-long journey from the Maasai Mara to the Serengeti, returning for the January through March calving season—the optimal time to view a phenomenon regarded as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of Africa.





## DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

### U.S. or Canada/ Arusha, Tanzania

#### Day 1-2

Depart your home city and arrive in Arusha, nestled at the foot of Mount Meru and the gateway to Tanzania's renowned national game parks. Transfer to the deluxe

ARUSHA SERENA HOTEL.

### Arusha/Serengeti National Park

#### Day 3

Enjoy a scenic, privately chartered flight over the African plains to the legendary, UNESCO World Heritage-designated Serengeti National Park.

On a game drive to the lodge, look for fauna such as Thomson's gazelle, giraffes, and leopards. Check into the deluxe SERENGETI SERENA SAFARI LODGE and enjoy a Welcome Reception.

### Serengeti National Park

#### Day 4-5

Experience a sublime spectacle of nature,

surrounded by great herds of wildebeest, gazelle, topi, zebra, and Cape buffalo during morning and afternoon game safaris.

Opt to participate in an early-morning balloon safari flight for a view from above.

### Serengeti National Park/ Olduvai Gorge/ Ngorongoro Conservation Area

#### Day 6

Visit the "cradle of mankind" at Olduvai Gorge—the most famous archaeological location in East Africa.

Enjoy some game-viewing as you continue to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Check into the NGORONGORO SERENA SAFARI LODGE, where each guest room offers stunning views of the crater.

### Ngorongoro Conservation Area

#### Day 7

Board a four-wheel-drive land cruiser and descend

2,000 feet to the floor of Ngorongoro Crater—a sanctuary for hundreds of mammal and bird species—for a morning of game tracking.

Look for parades of wildebeest, gazelle, Cape buffalo, zebra, and elephant. Watch for the critically endangered black rhinoceros and look for hippopotamus seeking refuge from the midday sun in the Ngoitokitok Springs. Later, survey the crater and abundant wildlife from your lodge's viewing terrace, right on the crater's rim.

### Ngorongoro Conservation Area/ Lake Manyara National Park

#### Day 8

Learn more about Tanzania's educational system firsthand during a visit to the Kibaoni Primary School, continuing on to Lake Manyara National Park and the LAKE MANYARA SERENA SAFARI LODGE.

Embark on an afternoon game drive in search of tree climbing lions, pink flamingos, and one of Tanzania's biggest elephant populations.

### Lake Manyara National Park/ Maramboi for Tarangire

#### Day 9

Visit a typical Maasai village to see the local people dressed in colorful traditional vestments. Then enjoy a picturesque

## Tarangire National Park

### Day 10

Rise with the African sun for a game drive after breakfast. Enjoy lunch in the TARANGIRE SAFARI LODGE and watch for herds of elephant gathering

near the drying riverbed and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, gazelle, and eland crowding the banks. This evening, attend the Farewell Reception.

## Arusha/U.S. or Canada Day 11-12

After a scenic drive from Lake Manyara to Arusha,

enjoy lunch at the Arusha Coffee Plantation.

After lunch, continue to the ARUSHA SERENA HOTEL for day-room accommodations. This evening, transfer to the airport for your return flight home to the U.S. or Canada, which arrives the next day.

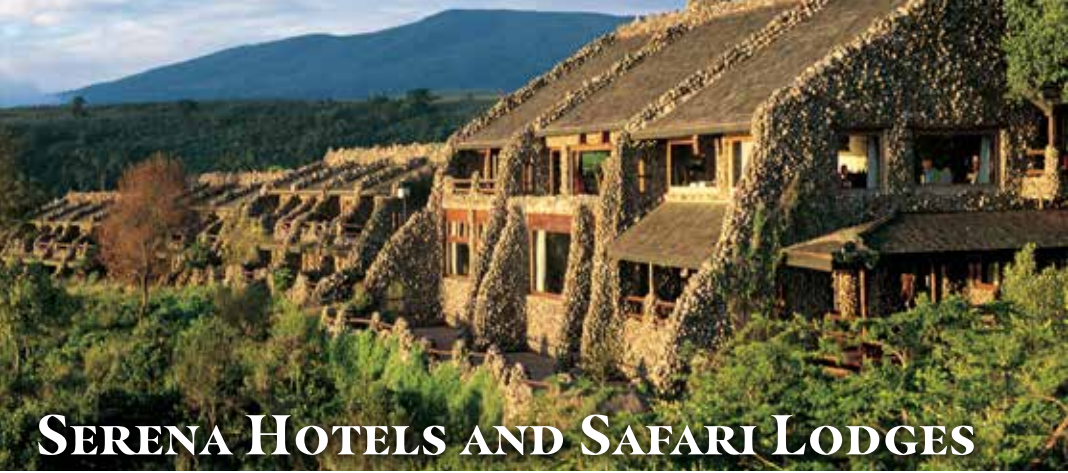
