Criteria for Applicants

Before submitting your application, please review the following criteria to ensure that you are eligible to apply for this scholarship:

- Must be a currently enrolled fulltime student at UC Davis having completed a minimum of 39 college units completed.
- Must have demonstrated leadership in student organizations, clubs, community activities, employment, and/or personal situations.
- Priority will be given to students based on financial need.
- Must be receiving financial aid such as, loans, work study or have "unmet" need.

How to Apply

- Fill out biographical information.
- Please submit a copy of your MyAwards budget page in order to establish financial need/eligibility.
- Write up to a 500-word essay describing how your leadership experiences have helped you to define your education and career goals at UC Davis. This essay should include your responses to the following questions:
 - a. Using at least two examples, tell us how you have contributed to the support of LGBTQIA students at UC Davis. Examples: involvement in student organizations, clubs, community activities, employment or personal situations, etc.
 - b. Please describe the current financial hardships you are facing as you work towards completing your degree.
- On a separate piece of paper (and up to an additional 500-word essay), compose a letter to an
 incoming LGBTQIA student describing how you used the resources on and off campus to help you
 adapt to the academic and social environment at UC Davis. How would you advise this student to
 prepare for the challenges that lie ahead?
