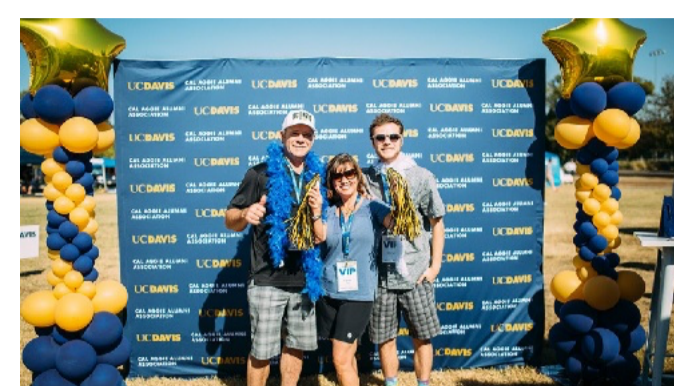
Homecoming Pep Rally

CHANCELL-ING: The Joys of Living and Learning in a College Town

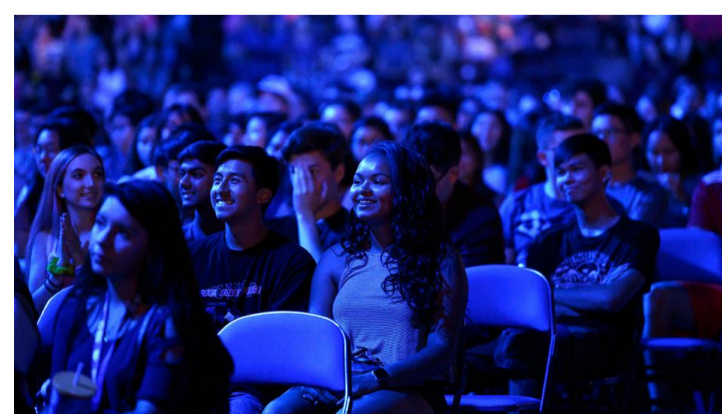
So this is what it's like to live in a college town.
